May 20 DAY 6 ASSISI -VENICE After breakfast, we proceed to Venice. In the afternoon we embark on a haft day tour of trip to magnificent Venice. We proceed to take a Vaporetto (water taxi) or our own private boat to this charming city built atop 118 tiny islands without streets, crisscrossed by 160 canals and linked by 400 footbridges. Explore all the sights and sounds of St. Mark's Square, visit the Basilica was built to house the Saints remains, the Bell Tower and the Palace of the Dodges. Here, Ignatius remained in an all-night vigil before the altar of the Virgin where he hung up his armament, sword, and all signs of his military past. We'll celebrate Eucharist in the chapel behind the Black Madonna. Dinner & overnight Barcelona

May 24 DAY 10 ZARAGOZA After breakfast we board our coach to Zaragoza and visit the Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar, the name given to the Blessed Virgin Mary who supernaturally appeared to the Apostle St James the Greater in AD 40 while he was preaching. This was the first Marian Apparition, although itis unique because it is the only one to have occurred while Mary was still alive on Earth. Overnight in Zaragoza

# May 25 DAY 11 ONWARDS TO LOURDES - MOTHER DEAREST, WE COME TO THEE....

Dinner and overnight at your hotel. in Lourdes

May 27 DAY 13 LOURDES - SALAMANCA After breakfast, board your coach to begin your journey to Loyola via the bustling university town of Salamanca in Spain. Sit back and enjoy the drive through the beautiful and scenic countryside. Salamanca, known as the Golden City owing to the colour of its historic sandstone buildings. We visit La Clerical, a church and college of the Jesuit Order, constructed in the seventeenth century; La Casa de las Conchas, currently a public library, but also a monument noted and decorated by its shells, symbolizing the ever-famous pilgrimage to Santiago (El Camino); the University of Salamanca, the oldest University in Spain and the third oldest in Europe; the two joint Salamanca Cathedrals (old and new), one of a Gothic/Romanesque style and the other a Renaissance style, respectively; the Roman Bridge, extending along the River Tormes, is a national monument and among one of Salamanca's sturdiest bridges; La Iglesia de San Marcos, constructed in Romanesque style, containing breathtaking paintings that portray many scenes of Our Lady's life. Overnight in Salamanca.

May 28 DAY 14 FATIMA This morning after breakfast, we drive to Fatima we visit the village and home of the three children Jacinta, Lucia and Francisco. Then we proceed on a tour of the Square (the largest square in Christendom) including the sites of the Apparitions, Rosary Basilica with the tombs of the visionaries and the Blessed Sacrament Chapel and other main sites. Later follow along the beautiful Way of the Cross along the Via Sacra (The Sacred Way) culminating in the chapel of Calvary, which overlooks all of Fatima, rest of the day is free for you to visit the holy places on your own. Dinner and overnight at Fatima

May 29 DAY 15 GOODBYE EUROPE Early in the morning after breakfast, it is time to say goodbye to Europe as you board your coach to the airport for your flight back home.
