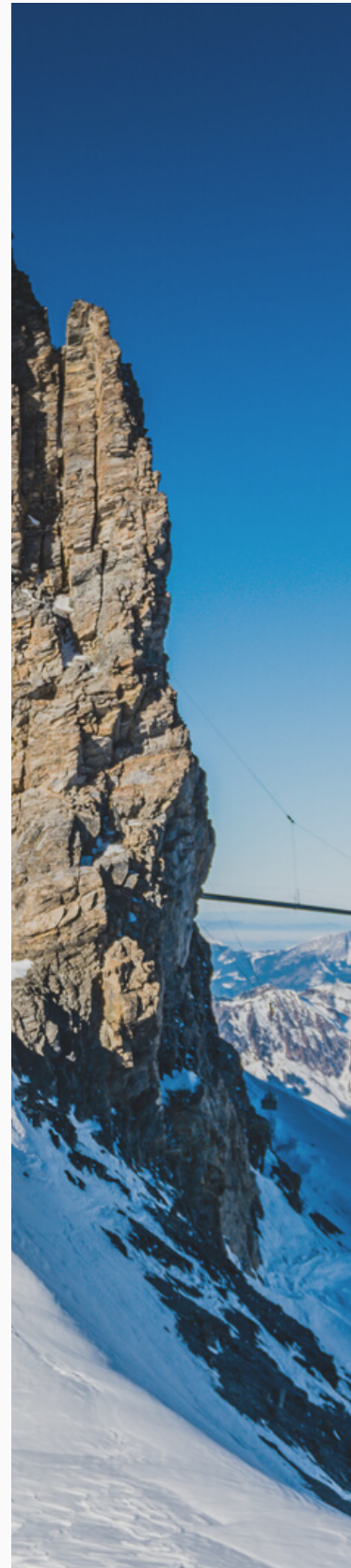

DAY 1

CANADA - GENEVA

Depart CANADA by flight to Geneva. Overnight onboard.

DAY 2

ARRIVE GENEVA

Enjoy dinner and overnight stay at your hotel in Geneva

DAY 3

GENEVA

Today after breakfast discover and get acquainted with this cosmopolitan international city and its most iconic sights, like the beautiful Lac Lemman, United Nations, Geneva Flower Clock, and Parc des Eaux Vives. Marvel at the distinctive beauty of Jet d'Eau; gaze at the shimmering surface of Lake Geneva; and disembark for a leisurely walking tour around Geneva's charming Old Town. Climb aboard the city's quaint mini-train to discover landmarks like St Pierre Cathedral and the Palace of Nations. Take a tour of all the international organisations: UNICEF, UNESCO, Red Cross, WIPO, WHO, WTO, WMO Dinner and overnight at hotels in Geneva.



DAY 4

GENEVA – LUCERNE

Today after a scrumptious breakfast we travel to Lucerne, where we visit Mount Pilatus, which includes a gondola ride and an aerial cableway ascent to the peak of Mount Pilatus, followed by a descent on the world's steepest cogwheel train.

On our return we stop at the beautiful city of Lucerne situated on the shores of Lake Lucerne. On your orientation tour, walk along the covered wooden Kappellbrucke (chapel bridge) to the Jesuit Chapel at the other end, pause at the poignant lion monument, built to commemorate the brave Swiss soldiers killed during the French Revolution or feed the swans by the lake.

Today a chance for you to shop for Swiss chocolates, cheese and SWISS watches at the various shops. After a delicious Dinner, overnight at your Hotel.



DAY 5

LUCERNE ENGELBERG (SWITZERLAND) – MT. TITLIS

DAY 8

INNSBRUCK – WATTENS SWAROVSKI

Today after breakfast we proceed by coach for Wattens. Visit SWAROVSKI CRYSTAL WORLD, to be dazzled at the chambers of Wonder! In the museum come face to face with the world's biggest crystal and the wall of crystals. People from all corners of the globe have been thrilled by the Swarovski experience... we are happy to give you the same. Enjoy lunch in the afternoon

Innsbruck is one of the most scenic places in the world and also known as JEWEL OF THE ALPS. Located on the Inn River, Innsbruck is one of Europe's most beautiful and lively cities. We will take you on an orientation tour of this beautiful city. View the Golden roof of Goldenes Dachl .an ornate Gothic balcony erected by the Emperor Maximilian I in the 15th century decorated with gold painted copper shingles. Walk through the quaint streets for a photo stop and see the Holburg or imperial Palace. This Capital of the Alps has a history of 800 years! After a delicious dinner, overnight at your hotel.



DAY 9

INNSBRUCK – SALZBERG

After breakfast our tour takes you to Salzburg, where you will visit the most popular sights Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart & the Trapp family. On a guided walk through the historical centre of Salzburg, you will see the episcopal city's main attractions, including the cathedral, the Festival Hall and Mozart's birthplace. From there, we continue on to some of the locations where the famous "Sound of Music" was filmed and to Mirabell Palace, which affords an impressive view of Hohensalzburg Fortress. Then you will have some time to explore the city, have lunch or shop for souvenirs. Dinner and overnight in Salzerbg



DAY 10

SALZBURG – VIENNA

This morning after breakfast we will drive to Vienna, once the center of the mighty Habsburg Empire. Start your afternoon sightseeing. Explore the imperial splendor of Vienna at Hofburg Palace, the former winter residence of the Habsburg Dynasty during your guided sightseeing tour of Vienna with a 'Local Specialist'. Admire the grand State Opera House and Ring Strasse, a beautiful sweeping boulevard built in the 19th-century to replace the city walls. Then, see the ornate colorful roof of St. Stephen's Cathedral, one of the city's most beloved icons. Visit the Baroque Schönbrunn Palace with its tranquil gardens. Overnight in Vienna

DAY 12

VIENNA – BRATISLAVA

After breakfast, we depart to the beautiful capital of Slovakia – Bratislava, set along the Danube River by the border with Austria and Hungary. This city is surrounded by Vineyards and the Little Carpathian Mountains, crisscrossed with forested hiking and cycling trails. Bratislava offers a sumptuous panoramic view of the city, admire the Baroque architecture, the 15th Century Castle, the Slovak National Theatre and National Gallery, the Music Academy and St. Martin Cathedral.



DAY 13

BRATISLAVA – LJUBLJANA

European Green capital ; We drive early morning to Ljubljana through the beautiful countryside. On the way to Ljubljana, the river flows through unique and natural landscape of Ljubljana marshes. Arrive into the green city and after we have a delicious lunch, spend the day with our guide as we check and see the sustainability projects around the city's green nooks and crannies that earned Ljubljana the prestigious European Green Capital 2016 award. The city houses two beautiful parks – Tivoli and Botanic Garden, and is a city of beautiful and architecturally interesting bridges. Ljubljana has various beehives and apiaries in locations across the city and the old city center is landscaped with tree lined riverside walks and weeping willow-lined terraces. Dinner and overnight in Ljubljana..



DAY 14

LJUBLJANA – PADOVA – VENICE

After breakfast we drive through stretches of beautiful landscapes to the beautiful city of Padua and the magnificent Basilica of St. Anthony. Walk through the Beautiful Padua square with its lovely gardens and fountains. Lunch at Padova and then we check into our hotel. After a delicious dinner Overnight in Padua / Mestre.

VENICE - ST. MARK'S SQUARE MURANO GLASS FACTORY

After breakfast, we embark on a full day trip to magnificent Venice. BALANCE PAYMENTS

AMENDMENTS

A transfer from one tour to another will be treated as a cancellation from a tour and a fresh booking of another. Therefore, cancellation rules will apply. Tour Itinerary/ Hotel/ Airlines/ Flights/ routes are subject to change without prior information.

CANCELLATION

All services such as airline seats / hotel accommodation / ground transportation are pre-booked well in advance. We are liable to pay penalties to all our suppliers/ vendors if these services are released within the mentioned period.
