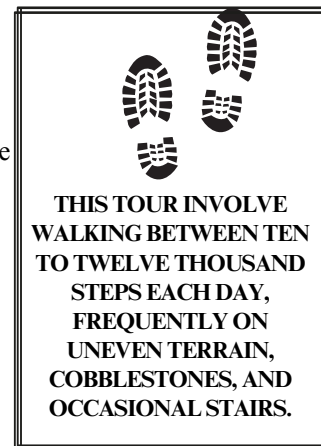
BOOKINGS AND DEPOSITS - You must complete and sign the official Royale Orchid Registration and Consent form provided and read terms and conditions of the tour below. Please enclose an initial Non-Refundable / Non-Transferable deposit of \$500 per person (adult / child) towards the cost of the tour. All cheques must be payable to Royale Orchid Tours and Holidays upon which you will receive an official receipt. Your receipt is written confirmation of your tour.

BALANCE PAYMENTS - Balance payments towards the costs of the tour must reach us 120 days / 4 months prior to departure of the tour Date.

AMENDMENTS - A transfer from one tour to another will be treated as a cancellation from a tour and a fresh booking of another. Therefore, cancellation rules will apply. **Tour Itinerary/ Hotel/ Airlines/ Flights/ routes are subject to change without prior information. While every effort will be made to operate the tour as outlined, the itinerary should be regarded as a general guide rather than a guaranteed schedule. Local conditions, religious or national holidays, traffic, security measures, strikes, or other unforeseen circumstances may require adjustments to the order of visits or the omission of certain sites.**

DAY 1 BEGIN YOUR HOLY LAND TOUR...

Departure Meet at the Airport for the flight: All information will be provided in advance at the pre-departure meeting.

DAY 2 BEGIN YOUR HOLYLAND TOUR...

Arrive at Tel Aviv Airport, and once we complete all airport formalities, proceed to Israel. Check into your hotel. Overnight at Hotel.

DAY 3 O HOLY LAND HAIFA - NAZARETH

After breakfast, begin your Divine Tour of the Holy Land with a scenic drive through Tel Aviv and the Sharon Valley, stopping to see the Crusader Walls and Roman Aqueduct. Visit Stella Maris Church in Haifa, followed by a view of the beautiful Persian Hanging Gardens and the Bahá'í Shrine. Celebrate Mass at Stella Maris before heading to Nazareth to visit the Church of the Annunciation, St. Joseph's Workshop, and Mary's Well. Conclude the day with dinner and overnight at your first-class hotel in Nazareth.

DAY 4 CANA, THE SEA OF GALILEE

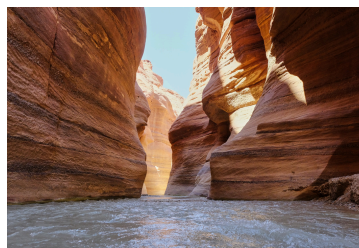
After breakfast, visit the little Church of Cana to commemorate Jesus' first miracle of turning water into wine, with an opportunity to renew wedding vows during Mass. Continue through the scenic Galilean countryside to the Sea of Galilee, where Jesus calmed the storm and walked on water. Enjoy a peaceful boat ride on a replica of a Galilean fishing boat. Then visit the traditional Baptismal Site at the Jordan River. End the day at the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount, and admire the beautiful Italian church overlooking the sea.

DAY 5 CHURCH OF THE MULTIPLICATION OF LOAVES AND FISHES, THE HOUSE OF PETER

After breakfast, visit Tabgha to see the Church of the Multiplication, featuring a 4th-century mosaic commemorating the miracle of the loaves and fishes. Continue to the Church of the Primacy of Peter, built on the shore where Jesus reinstated Peter. In Capernaum, reflect on Christ's Galilean ministry as you visit the House of Peter and the ancient synagogue where He preached. If time permits, take a taxi to the Church of the Transfiguration. Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Primacy or Transfiguration. Return to your hotel in Nazareth for dinner and overnight.

DAY 6 JERUSALEM & BETHLEHEM

After breakfast, depart for Jerusalem via the scenic Jordan Valley. Stop at the Dead Sea—the lowest point on Earth—for a relaxing float at a private beach with all entry and shower fees covered. Continue to Jericho, the world's oldest city, where you may refresh yourself at Elisha's Spring (if open). Take a cable car ride to the Mount of Temptation and see the Sycamore Tree that Zacchaeus climbed to see Jesus. This is also where Jesus healed the blind man.





DAY 7 O HOLY TOWN OF BETHLEHEM

After lunch, proceed to Bethlehem, the City of David. Visit Manger Square and the Church of the Nativity, where the highlight for any pilgrim is time spent in the Grotto of the Nativity—the sacred spot where Jesus was born. Continue to Shepherds’ Field, where the angel announced Christ’s birth to the shepherds. In the evening, check into your first-class hotel in Bethlehem. Enjoy a delicious dinner and retire for the night.

DAY 8 WALK IN THE WAY OF LORD

After breakfast, begin a walking pilgrimage through Jerusalem’s Old City via the Dung Gate. As you enter, take in the vibrant atmosphere, reminiscent of ancient times. Walk the Via Dolorosa, the cobblestone path Jesus took to His crucifixion, pausing at each Station of the Cross, including the rock where tradition says Jesus placed His hand and the stone melted. Enter the Church of the Holy Sepulcher to visit the site of the crucifixion and the Tomb where Jesus was buried and rose on the third day. View the Golden Dome of the Rock (exterior only). Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 9 JERUSALEM & MASADA

After Breakfast, we then visit to the Pater Noster Church, where Jesus taught the Lord’s Prayer —displayed in ceramic tiles in many languages. After lunch, visit Mount Zion to see King David’s Tomb and the Upper Room of the Last Supper. End the day at the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations, where Jesus prayed before His arrest. Then we go visit Masada. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.



DAY 10 TEL AVIV

Tel Aviv can still see the traditional site of Simon the Tanner’s house in the Old City of Jaffa. While praying in Jaffa, Peter saw a vision of a sheet descending from heaven filled with animals considered unclean. God’s command to “kill and eat” symbolized that the Gospel was for all people, not just Jews. It remains a pilgrimage stop for Christians retracing the footsteps of the Apostles. Overnight and dinner.
