However, it is not valid for travel on tour.

BALANCE PAYMENTS – Balance payments towards the costs of the tour must reach us at least 90 days prior to departure of the tour Date.

AMENDMENTS – A transfer from one tour to another will be treated as a cancellation from a tour and a fresh booking of another. Therefore, cancellation rules will apply. Tour Itinerary/ Hotel/ Airlines/ Flights/ routes are subject to change without prior information.

CANCELLATION – All services such as airline seats / hotel accommodation / ground transportation are pre-booked well in advance. We are liable to pay penalties to all our suppliers/ vendors if these services are released within the mentioned period.

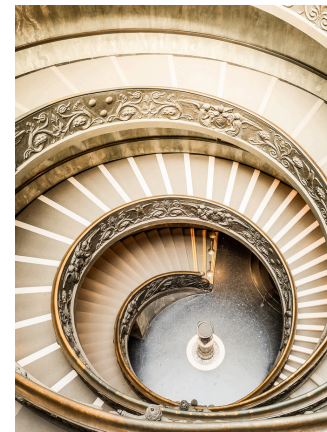


DAY 1 – DEPARTURE FROM CANADA

Pack your bags and set off on your tour. Departure from Vancouver to Rome

DAY 02: ARRIVE IN ROME

Depart Canada by flight for Italy, on arrival at Rome Airport we clear all formalities and proceed to board our coach to our Hotel in Rome. This evening enjoy a delicious Dinner. Overnight at the hotel in Rome.



DAY 03: ROME – VATICAN & PANORAMIC CITY TOUR OF ROME

After breakfast we board our coach to Vatican City, the smallest nation in the World.Today is the Papal audience (subject to no changes to the schedule of the Pope).

The most famous square of Vatican City is St. Peters Square with St Peter's Basilica, the largest church in the World, unsurpassed in beauty to which millions of tourists and pilgrims come from around the world. Gaze in awe at Michelangelo's Pieta and Bernini's amazing bronze canopy.

After a delicious lunch at a Continental restaurant, get into world like no other in the Vatican Museum, see awe inspiring relics and works of art. The Tapestry gallery, Raphael Rooms and the most overwhelming Sistine Chapel, Michelangelo's masterpiece on the ceiling and his famous last Judgement. Rome was not built in a day, the truth of this oft-quoted adage hits you with full force, as we proceed for sightseeing tour of a lifetime. The Basilica of St. John in Lateran, the Victor Emmanuel Monument, and Tribute is paid to the brave Gladiators of Rome, as you pass the mighty Colosseum. Pass the ruins of the Roman Forum and end at the famous Trevi fountain. Legend has it, that if you make a wish and toss a coin over your left shoulder into the fountain, you are sure to return to Rome. After a delicious dinner, overnight in your Hotel in Rome.

DAY 04: ROME – ASSISI

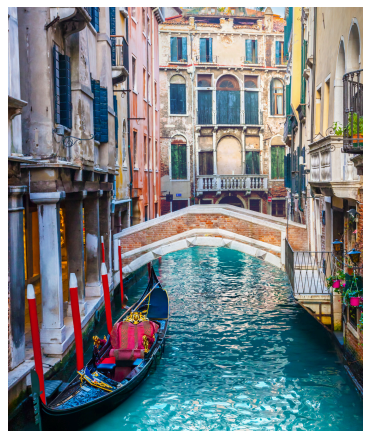
Today after breakfast, we board our coach and drive towards Padua, en route we will visit the quaint town of Assisi. On arrival at Assisi we will explore this hilltop town and walk the narrow winding streets with its story book stores and shops. Towering above the town is the Basilica that still retains something of the atmosphere of the early 1200s. Take in the view of the countryside from the top of the huge 13th century Basilica which also has many of St. Francis' possessions and a series of frescoes depicting his life. Over night in Assisi

DAY 05 – ASSISI – PADUA – MESTRE

After breakfast we board our coach and proceed towards Padua and drive through stretches of olive groves and vineyards to the beautiful city of Padua and the magnificent Basilica of St. Anthony. Walk through the beautiful Padua Square with its lovely gardens and fountains. Later after a delicious dinner check into your hotel. Overnight in Mestre.

DAY 06: VENICE – ST. MARKS SQUARE – MURANO GLASS FACTORY – TURIN

After breakfast, we embark on a Half day trip to magnificent Venice. We proceed to take a Vaporetto (water taxi) or our own private boat to this charming city built atop 118 tiny islands without streets, crisscrossed by 160 canals and linked by 400 footbridges. Explore all the sights and sounds of St. Mark's Square, the Basilica was built to house the Saints remains, the Bell Tower and the Palace of the Dodges. Stop for a photograph at the Bridge of Sighs, feed the pigeons or visit the World-famous Murano Glass Factory and learn the art of glass blowing.



Next, it's on to Turin, en route we enjoy a packed lunch. We arrive into Turin and visit the Holy Shroud, kept in the Royal Chapel of the Cathedral of Saint John the Baptist. We also visit the Basilica of Mary Help of Christians, it was originally part of the home for poor boys founded by St. Don Bosco. It contains the remains of Saint John Bosco and 6000 relics of other saints. According to legend a vision of the Virgin Mary appeared in a dream to Saint John Bosco in 1844 and revealed the site of the martyrdom of the Turinese saints. The Basilica was built on the site of their death. After a delicious dinner, overnight at your Hotel in Turin.

DAY 07 MONTPELLIER, FRANCE

This morning after breakfast, we go to Montpellier France.

DAY 08: BARCELONA

We proceed to Catalonia's lively and beautiful capital, Barcelona. We visit the pilgrimage site of Montserrat and its countryside. Situated 4,055 feet above sea level in a mountain range composed of striking pink conglomerate a form of sedimentary rock, this is the site of the Benedictine abbey that boasts the Black Virgin of Montserrat Sanctuary, patron saint of Catalonia. Dinner & overnight Barcelona

DAY 09: BARCELONA

After breakfast enjoy a guided sightseeing tour which includes a drive around Montjuic to see the Olympic Stadium and a great panoramic view of the port and city. Continue to the city center's Plaza Catalunya and Paseo de Gracia to admire Gaudi's eccentric Houses Batllo and Mila as well as his SAGRADA FAMILIA, an unfinished architectural masterpiece that is still a consecrated expression of the Catholic faith. Dinner & overnight in Barcelona



Day 10: Barcelona – Zaragoza

After breakfast we board our coach to Zaragoza and visit the Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar, the name given to the Blessed Virgin Mary who supernaturally appeared to the Apostle St James the Greater in AD 40 while he was preaching. This was the first Marian Apparition, although it is unique because it is the only one to have occurred while Mary was still alive on Earth. Overnight in Zaragoza.

DAY 11: ONWARDS TO LOURDES – MOTHER DEAREST, WE COME TO THEE....

Early morning, we board our coach to Lourdes, packed lunch will be provided. Sit back in the comfort of your coach and watch the countryside fly by as we zoom towards Lourdes. We arrive in the picturesque Lourdes, the birthplace of St. Bernadette to whom Our Lady appeared in 1859 near the Grotto of Massabielle. After dinner, proceed for the evening rosary at the Grotto, a spiritually uplifting moment. Overnight at your hotel in Lourdes.

DAY 12: LOURDES – A DAY WITH OUR MOTHER

After breakfast, the day is free for personal activities. Connect with the Lord during mass at the awe inspiring underground Basilica of St. Pius X, learn and be inspired by the story of Lourdes and walk in the footsteps of St. Bernadette at the movie presentation. Walk the station of the Cross on the mountain overlooking Lourdes, visit the relic room and drink from the water of the miraculous spring. Continue with your visits to the shrine till late evening. Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Lourdes.

DAY 16: LISBON

Today after breakfast we head for a guided sightseeing tour of Lisbon, the bustling capital City of Portugal. See the enormous monument dedicated to Henry the navigator, as well as the 16th century Belem Tower, the Moorish Citadel, and the impressive Black Horse Square. Visit the CATHEDRAL LA SE where St. Anthony was baptized, and JERONIMOS MONASTERY, which dates back to the mid-1400's and was built in reverence to the Virgin Mary for Vasco de Gama's successful voyage to India. Overnight at your hotel.

DAY 17: GOODBYE EUROPE

Today after breakfast, it is time to say goodbye to Europe as you board your coach to the airport for your flight back home. Good times need never end, after your check - in formalities are completed, sit back, relax, and enjoy the in-flight services and meals as you relive the high points of your tour.

DAY 13: ONWARDS TO SPAIN AND PORTUGAL – FATIMA VIA SALAMANCA

After breakfast, board your coach to begin your journey to Fatima via the bustling university town of Salamanca in Spain. Sit back and enjoy the drive through the beautiful and scenic countryside. We will stop for a packed lunch en route. After lunch continue towards Salamanca, known as the Golden City owing to the colour of its historic sandstone buildings. We arrive into the city late evening and proceed for dinner. Overnight in Salamanca.

DAY 14: FATIMA

After breakfast, as we drive to Fatima, the excitement mounts as we draw closer to Our Mother. The atmosphere of intense spirituality and the importance of Fatima have been attested to by the visits of two Popes: Paul VI and Jon Paul II. Proceed on a tour of the Square (the largest square in Christendom) including the sites of the Apparitions, Rosary Basilica with the tombs of the visionaries and the Blessed Sacrament Chapel and other main sites. Later follow along the beautiful Way of the Cross along the Via Sacra (The Sacred Way) culminating in the chapel of Calvary, which overlooks all of Fatima, rest of the day is free for you to visit the holy places on your own. Dinner and overnight in Hotel.
