Day 4: Paris to Nevers


Overnight in Lourdes

We proceed to Nevers, where Bernadette was buried. It was to Bernadette Soubirous, a simple and humble young girl, that the Virgin Mary chose to appear in Lourdes on several occasions in 1858. She presented herself as the Immaculate Conception. Bernadette joined the sisters of Charity of Nevers where she took care of sick and poor people. A poor young girl, chosen among all by the Virgin Mary, she will make her poverty a real wealth: "Jesus alone for Riches" (Sister Bernadette). Evening enjoys delicious dinner at a restaurant.

DAY 5: Onwards to Lourdes: Lourdes - Mother Dearest, we come to Thee...

After dinner we proceed to our hotel. Overnight in Nevers.

Early next morning, we board our coach to Lourdes. Packed breakfast will be provided. Sit back in the comfort of the coach and watch the countryside fly by as we zoom towards Lourdes. We arrive in the Picturesque Lourdes, the birthplace of St. Bernadette to whom Our lady appeared in 1858 near the grotto of Massabielle. After dinner, proceed for the evening rosary at the Grotto, a spiritual uplifting moment.













DAY 6: Lourdes (A Day with our mother)

After breakfast, day is free for personal activities. Connect with the lord during mass at the awe-inspiring underground Basilica of St. Pius X, learn and be inspired by the story of Lourdes and walk in the footsteps of St. Bernadette at the movie presentation, walk the path of the stations of the Cross on the mountain overlooking Lourdes, visit the relic room and drink from the water of the miraculous spring. Continue with your visit to the shrine till late evening. After an early dinner at the hotel. Overnight in Lourdes.

Day 07: Lourdes- Santander

This morning after breakfast, we proceed to Santander. Santander is the capital city of the Cantabria region on Spain's north coast. The Palacio de la Magdalena, once the royal

summer residence, lies at the mouth of the Bay of Santander on the rocky La Magdalena Peninsula. West, the city center is home to the Catedral de Santander, with its octagonal cupola and Gothic cloister. Dinner & overnight in Santander.

Day 08 : Santander-Santiago de Compostela

After breakfast in Santander, we proceed to Santiago de Compostela has been known throughout history for the key 9th century pilgrimage route, the Camino de Santiago (or Way of St James) to ST JAMES Cathedral, which houses the Apostle James remains beneath the high Altar. We go to Cabo Finisterre, where pilgrims have traditionally completed their walk

and burned their robes.

Dinner & overnight at Santiago De Compostela

DAY 9: Santiago de Compostela- Fatima

The atmosphere of intense spirituality and the importance of Fatima have been attested to by the visits of two Popes: Paul VI and Jon Paul II. Proceed on a tour of the Square (the largest square in Christendom) including the sites of the Apparitions, Rosary Basilica with the tombs of the visionaries and the Blessed Sacrament Chapel and other main sites. Later follow along the beautiful Way of the Cross along the Via Sacra (The Sacred Way) culminating in the chapel of Calvary, which overlooks all of Fatima, rest of the day is free for you to visit the holy places on your own. Dinner and overnight in hotel in Fatima.

DAY 10: Fatima

This morning after breakfast, we visit the village and home of the three children Jacinta, Lucia and Francisco. This afternoon after lunch you have your own personal time to devotion and prayer to our dear Mother. Dinner and overnight at Fatima.

DAY 11: Lisbon

Today after breakfast we head for a guided sightseeing tour of Lisbon, the bustling capital City of Portugal. See the enormous monument dedicated to Henry the navigator, as well as the

16th century Belem Tower, the Moorish Citadel, and the impressive Black Horse Square. Visit the CATHEDRAL LA SE where St. Anthony was baptized, and JERONIMOS MONASTERY, which dates back to the mid-1400's and was built in reverence to the Virgin Mary for Vasco de Gama's successful voyage to India. Overnight at your hotel in Lisbon.

Day 12: Lisbon- Madrid

Today after breakfast, we will leave Lisbon and will go to Madrid. Lunch and dinner will be provided. Free time in Madrid.

Day 13: Madrid

After breakfast, we will leave for a guided tour. Set out on a half-day tour to visit a pair of Madrid icons, the Prado Museum and the Royal Palace. The Prado Museum is one of the most important art galleries in the world. Its main corpus is nourished by the royal collections treasured for centuries by different imperial dynasties. Together with Las Meninas de Velázquez and Goya's May 3rd 1808, the galleries are full of masterpieces from the Spanish, Italian and Flemish schools. After your visit of the Prado, you'll continue to Madrid's Royal Palace, visiting the largest palace in all of Western Europe. Built during the 18th century by Felipe V, the first king of the bourbon dynasty, it is used in modern times by the Spanish Crown. As you visit, admire the official reception rooms, the museum area, the Royal Chapel, the Throne Room and the private rooms of King Carlos III and Queen Isabel II. Conclude with a transfer back to your hotel. Diner and overnight in Madrid.

Day 14: Madrid -Zaragoza

After breakfast we board our coach to Zaragoza and visit the Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar, the name given to the Blessed Virgin Mary who supernaturally appeared to the Apostle St James the Greater in AD 40 while he was preaching. This was the first Marian Apparition, although it is unique because it is the only one to have occurred while Mary was still alive on Earth. Overnight in Zaragoza.

Day 15: Zaragoza- Barcelona

Today after breakfast in Zaragoza on our way to Barcelona we will visit the pilgrimage site of Montserrat and its countryside. Situated 4,055 feet above sea level in a mountain range composed of striking pink conglomerate a form of sedimentary rock, this is the site of the Benedictine abbey that boasts the Black Virgin of Montserrat Sanctuary, patron saint of Catalonia. Dinner & overnight Barcelona

Day 16: Barcelona

After breakfast enjoy a guided sightseeing tour which includes a drive around Montjuic to see the Olympic Stadium and a great panoramic view of the port and city. Continue to the city center's Plaza Catalunya and Paseo de Gracia to admire Gaudi's eccentric Houses Batllo and Mila as well as his SAGRADA FAMILIA, an unfinished architectural masterpiece that is still a consecrated expression of the Catholic faith. Dinner & overnight in Barcelona

DAY 17: Goodbye Europe

Today after breakfast, it is time to say goodbye to Europe as you board your coach to the airport for your flight back home.
