DAY 1- DEPART FROM CANADA /USA

Depart from Vancouver/USA to Athens

DAY 2- ATHENS

you will arrive in Athens. Rest in the hotel. Dinner is included in the hotel.

DAY 3- ATHENS

Arrive in Athens. You will visit The Constitution of Greece. The Constitutional history of Greece goes back to the Greek War of Independence. Continue to the Old Parliament House which housed the Greek Parliament. Then, you will see The National Library of Greece which holds 4,500 Greek manuscripts, one of the greatest collections of Greek scripts. Visit the Presidential Palace, the official residence of the President of the Greek Republic, where you will see the Evzones in their picturesque uniform. On Your way to the Acropolis, you will see the Hadrian's Arch, visit the Temple of Olympian Zeus, and you will make a short stop at the Panathenaic Stadium.

Then you will visit the Acropolis Museum and see the findings of the archaeological site of the Acropolis of Athens. You will also visit the architectural masterpieces of the Golden Age of Athens: The Propylaea, the Temple of Athena Nike, and the Erechtheion. The last stop is The Parthenon, temple in Acropolis, the harmony between material and spirit, the monument that puts order in the mind.

DAY 4- ATHENS / SANTORINI

Arrive in Athens and take your flight to Santorini. You will have the rest of the day free to enjoy the stunningly gorgeous Greek Isle that is rumoured in legend to be the lost city of Atlantis. Walk in the paths of Fira, the picturesque capital of Santorini; perched high up on the edge of the Caldera and enjoy the views of the volcano, ocean, white-washed buildings, and blue domed churches. Visit Oia, Firostefani and Imerovigli and relax while seeing the most beautiful sunset in the world.

DAY 5- SANTORINI (SANTORINI ISLAND AND OIA SUNSET TOUR)

Day to enjoy the unique and spectacular sights of the island, the most romantic sunset of the world and the beautiful, white-washed houses. Today you will explore this unique island with Santorini Island and Oia Sunset Tour. The first stop is Pyrgos. Situated at the highest point of Santorini, the village offers an idyllic snapshot of old-world Greece. Follow your guide along the winding paths, past the sugar cube houses and blue-domed churches and make your way to the hilltop ruins of a medieval Venetian castle. From here, gaze out over the entire island, soaking up panoramic views all the way to the village of Oia. Continue to the highest area of the island, Profitis Elias shortstop for panoramic pictures. Continue to Oia village passing through villages of Firostefani Or Imerovigli. Oia, the quintessential Greek village that is known for its incredible sunsets. Stroll along the pretty streets with your guide, learning about the village's history.

DAY 6 - SANTORINI / ATHENS / KAYSERI / CAPPADOCIA

After the breakfast you leave for Santorini Airport for your flight to Athens. Arrive in Athens Airport . Take your flight and get ready to fly to Istanbul.



Fly from Istanbul to Kayseri Airport. Arrive Kayseri and enjoy the beautiful drive to Cappadocia with an overnight at your cave hotel.

DAY 7- CAPPADOCIA (FULL DAY EXCURSIONS IN NORTH CAPPADOCIA, UCHISAR , GOREME OPEN AIR MUSEUM TOUR)

Start your day with a beautiful tour in Cappadocia with breakfast. Start with a full day tour of Cappadocia where the sights of the Fairy Chimneys the natural wonder of Cappadocia is a result of volcanic deposits being eroded away by wind and water over millions of years. These soft rocks were hollowed out by early Christians and used as secret dwellings as they were being sought first by their Roman and later by Byzantine persecutors. You will also visit many churches that have been decorated with vivid frescoes which have withstood the corrosive effects of time. The excursions will start with the natural citadel of Uchisar which will enable you to get a panoramic view of the region. And then the Goreme Valley, which is the highlight of the day. This valley houses the Goreme Open Air Museum with its cave churches hewn out of rock and unique colorful frescoes, dating back to the early Christian era.; 10.-13. Centuries. The next stop is Zelve, Pasabag (Monk's Valley) Valleys, and the caves of this ancient village, the old Greek Village called Cavusin Village. Lunch at a local restaurant will be followed by visits to Avanos which is world famous with pottery making. Afternoon visits will continue with Devrent Valley and the biggest fairy chimneys of Urgup. On your return, a carpet factory will be visited to watch how carpets are woven with old looms.

DAY 8- CAPPADOCIA / PAMUKKALE (TOUR OF PAMUKKALE AND HIERAPOLIS)

After Breakfast leave Cappadocia and arrive in Pamukkale by bus, have lunch in the afternoon exploring the highlights of the bus tour on your way to Pamukkale. In Pamukkale visit the Cotton Castle where thermal spring waters laden with calcareous salts running off the plateau edge have formed dazzling white travertine cliffs. You will start with the tour of Hierapolis where the Romans founded a therapy center. The thermal resort was founded by a Pergamene king in 190 B.C and greatly enlarged and embellished by the Romans. The highlights of Hierapolis are Necropolis, Roman Baths, Domitian Gate, Latrina, Oil Factory, Frontinus Street, Agora, Byzantium Gate, Triton Fountain, Cathedral, Apollon Temple, Plutonium, Theater and Antique Pool. Overnight in your hotel. in Pamukkale.

DAY 9 – PAMUKKALE / KUSADASI / SELCUK (TOUR OF EPHEBUS AND HOUSE OF ST. MARY) (HOT AIR BALLOON)

Enjoy snacks and beverage service before the flight. charmed with incredible panoramic views of Pamukkale, as you fly up approximately 500-1000m. above the ground. Receive your flight certificate after landing. After your hot air balloon ride, we will leave to Kusadasi.



DAY 10- KUSADASI

Full day excursions to the town of Selcuk and the ancient city of Ephesus. First visit the Basilica of St. John, who came here with the Virgin Mary and wrote his Gospel. To the south west of the Basilica stands the Isa Bey Mosque and further in the same direction Temple of Artemis, one of the Seven Wonders of the World. Ephesus was undoubtedly one of the most important cultural centers of the ancient world. Impressive structures we will see include the Library of Celsus, Temple of Hadrian, Theatre and Odeon. We will also visit the Museum of Selcuk. Close by is the House of the Virgin Mary where she is believed to have spent her last years. On August 18th. 1961. Pope John XXII proclaimed the House of Virgin Mary at Ephesus to be sacred. You will have a chance to take some Holy Water from the Sacred Spring.

DAY 11 – KUSADASI – ISTANBUL (BOSPHORUS CRUISE WITH TURKISH NIGHT SHOW)

After breakfast at Kusadasi, you will be depart for going Istanbul. After arriving at Istanbul, you will be transfered to your hotel. Rest well and be ready for Bosphorus Dinner cruise with Turkish night show in the evening. This exciting dinner cruise presents you the beauty of Istanbul at night while cruising the Bosphorus river. You will dine on a delicious assortment of authentic Turkish cuisine, plus you enjoy an outstanding Turkish night of entertainment which will feature traditional dances from the seven different regions of Turkey as well as an oriental belly-dance show. This performance will include Ottoman dancers, Romany Gypsy girls, belly dancers and the Asuk Masuk comedy team etc. This is a night you will not forget. Dinner cruise ends at about midnight, at which time we will transfer you to the hotel.

DAY 12- ISTANBUL (FULL DAY TOUR OF OLD CITY ISTANBUL AND TOPKAPI PALACE)

Breakfast at the hotel will be followed by a full day tour of Old City Istanbul and Topkapi Palace. Drive to the Sultan Ahmet Center, the heart of the "Old City " from where the Byzantine and Ottoman Empires were ruled. Then visit The Museum Of Turkish and Islamic Arts, displaying art collections from different civilizations of Anatolia. Continue with the Blue Mosque, famous for its delicate blue ceramic tiles and then Saint Sophia, primarily a church – turned mosque – turned museum, which takes the breath away with the sheer architectural size of its interior and magnificent dome, continue with the visit to the bustling Grand Bazaar, biggest "souk" in the World with its more than 4000 shops and stalls. Enjoy shopping for almost anything (jewellery, antiques, carpets, textile, garments, spices, souvenirs, etc.).

Following the lunch afternoon visits will continue with the spectacular Topkapi Palace, imperial residence of Ottoman Sultans. Built on one of the seven hills of Istanbul, this huge complex commands the views of the Sea of Marmara, The Bosphorus, and the Golden Horn. Tour will continue with the Sultan Tombs; there are five tombs of Ottoman Sultans within the graveyard at Hagia Sophia.

DAY 13- LEISURE TIME

After breakfast, we will go for shopping and spend the rest of the day in Istanbul. Breakfast, lunch and dinner is included.

DAY 14- DEPARTURE FOR CANADA
