DAY 6: DELHI

After breakfast, we will go to visit the city. While visiting the city, we will visit the Qutub Minar. The Qutb Minar, also spelled Qutub Minar and Qutab Minar, is a <u>minaret</u> and "victory tower" that forms part of the <u>Qutb</u> <u>complex</u>, which lies at the site of Delhi's oldest fortified city, <u>Lal Kot</u>, founded by the <u>Tomar</u> Rajputs. It is a <u>UNESCO World Heritage Site</u> in the <u>Mehrauli</u> area of <u>South Delhi</u>, <u>India</u>. It is one of the most visited tourist spots in the city, mostly built between 1199 and 1220. It can be compared to the 62-metre all-brick <u>Minaret of Jam</u> in Afghanistan, of c. 1190, which was constructed a decade or so before the probable start of the Delhi tower. The surfaces of both are elaborately decorated with inscriptions and geometric patterns. The Qutab Minar has a shaft that is <u>fluted</u> with "superb <u>stalactite</u> bracketing under the balconies" at the top of each stage. In general, <u>minarets</u> were slow to be used in India and are often detached from the main mosque where they exist.

The intricate facade of the Hawa Mahal (Wind Palace) is possibly Jaipur's most photographed building. Maharaja Sawai Pratap Singh constructed it in 1799 as an extension of the women's guarters of the City Palace, to enable the royal women to look out over the main street below without being observed. Wind used to flow through the shutters, giving the palace its name. However, most are now sealed closed to help preserve them. Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II built Jaigarh Fort in 1726 to protect Amber Fort. This fort holds great appeal for military lovers, as it contains the world's largest cannon on wheels. The cannon has never been fired though, and neither has the fort been captured. As a result, it has remained impressively intact over its long life. In fact, the fort is one of the best-preserved military structures of medieval India.

DAY 10: DEPART FOR KOCHI

We will depart from Jaipur to Kochi. Upon reaching Kochi, we will relax at the hotel.



DAY 11: KOCHI

After Breakfast proceed to local sightseeing of Kochi., Take a photo stop at St. Francis Church, Visit to Jewish Synagogue and Dutch Palace (Subject to operation), see the Chinese Fishing Nets. Free time for shopping. Enjoy get-together with your travel companions in the evening.
