DAY 1 - DEPARTURE FROM CANADA TO IXTAPA

Departure from Vancouver to Mexico city to Ixtapa and arrival in Mexico city We will board our bus and drive to our hotel. Overnight in Ixtapa all inclusive.

DAY 2 IXTAPA

After breakfast, we celebrate mass. A guided tour of Ixtapa before lunch will be included. Lunch and Dinner will be provided. In the night we will rest in our hotel all inclusive in Ixtapa.

DAY 3 IXTAPA

Today after breakfast, we celebrate mass Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner will be provided. In the evening rest in our hotel all inclusive in Ixtapa.

DAY 4 IXTAPA TO MEXICO CITY

After breakfast we will take our flight from Ixtapa to Mexico city. In the morning, after breakfast, we will visit one of the biggest metropolis of the world - Mexico City - built on the site of the former capital of the Aztec Empire. Obligatory sightseeing points will be: Zocalo Square, which is the center of modern Mexico, the Metropolitan Cathedral, and the centrally located Presidential Palace (from outside). Check into our hotel in Mexico city.

DAY 5 TEOTIHUACAN

After breakfast, we will visit our lady of Guadalupe, we will request for mass over there. We will visit the Church of Santiago in the Three Cultures Square, where the baptized St. Juan Diego. Next, visit San Juan Teotihuacan, one of the most powerful cultural centers in Mesoamerica, a prominent political and religious center with complexes of monumental buildings such as the Citadel and the Temple of the Feathered Serpent, the Calzada de los Muertos and the Pyramids of the Sun and the Moon. A guided tour will reveal to you how the Aztecs used to work the obsidian stone and the multiple uses of the Maguey Plant, among many other interesting facts then we will have lunch there and also visit the stores where they make tequila. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

DAY 6 TAXCO

This morning after breakfast we go to the famous "Silver City"- Taxco. We get acquainted with the history of silver mining since Pre-Columbian times, visit jewels of baroque style architecture. Taxco is an enchanting and cozy town with its amazing Santa Prisca church from the 18th century. St Priscilla and St Sebastian Church where we celebrate Mass. Return to your hotel in Mexico city Dinner is included. We will return to our hotel and relax in our hotel.

DAY 7 MEXICO CITY

After breakfast this morning we will go to the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of the Americas. This church has become one of the most important pilgrimage sites for Catholics, and its history dates back to 1531 when a devout, poor Indian man named Juan Diego (an Aztec convert to Christianity) received a vision of the Virgin Mary on Tepeyac Hill near what is now Mexico City. We will visit the Basilica - the Old Basilica, the New Basilica, the Baptistry, the Indian Chapel, the chapel on Tepeyac Hill, and the bell tower. The new Basilica which was built in 1976, was designed by the eminent Mexican architect Pedro Ramirez Vasquez, and its form of creation resembles a tent, such as Moses erected on Mount Sinai. Free time for prayer and purchase of religious souvenirs and gifts. Mass will be at the shrine. after that Lunch will be provided. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

DAY 8 DEPARTURE DAY

We will have a breakfast in hotel and Transfer to the airport for our flight back arriving in Canada.
