DAY 02: ROME

On arrival in Rome we clear all formalities and proceed to board our Coach to the Hotel. This evening enjoy a delicious Dinner, overnight at Hotel in Rome.

DAY 03: ROME- VATICAN CHURCH

We visit Mary Major Santa Maria Maggiore which is one of the major basilicas in Rome. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

DAY 5: ROME - LANCIANO - ASSISI

After Breakfast, visit the Church of St. Francesco in Lanciano, a place where many pilgrims come every year. In the 7th century, the Eucharistic miracle happened in the walls of the monastery of St. Longinus (a contemporary church was eventually built in its place) – during the liturgy, bread and wine turned into body and blood in the hands of Basilian monk, who at that time had doubts about religion. Seeing this, the priest fell to his knees and began to pray, and the pilgrims began to come to the temple. Then we proceed to Assisi. overnight in Assisi.

DAY 6: ASSISI

After breakfast we will have mass at The Church of St. Mary Major then you will start your guided tour at the Basilica of St. Clare, dedicated to the close follower of St. Francis and the founder of the Order of Poor Clares. Explore the Basilica complex, which is divided into two levels:

- Upper Basilica: Known for its breathtaking frescoes by Giotto, depicting the life of St. Francis.
- Lower Basilica: Visit the richly decorated lower church with its stunning artwork and serene atmosphere.

Spend the evening at your leisure,, perhaps taking a stroll through the city. Rest well in your hotel. Over night in Assisi.

DAY 7: ASSISI - PISA

After breakfast, we drive to Pisa. a city known worldwide as the hometown of the great scientist Galileo Galilei.
