After lunch, visit the Vatican Museums, home to an incredible collection of art and historical artifacts. Highlights include the Stanzas of Raphael, rooms adorned with magnificent frescoes by the Renaissance master. ### Day 04: -POMPEII – AMALFI COAST

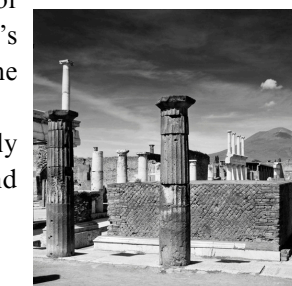
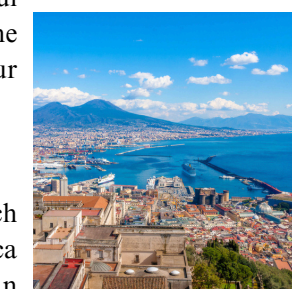
