DAY 2: TOUR BEGINS IN BAKU (AZERBAIJAN)


Welcome to Baku, the capital of Azerbaijan and the gateway to the Caspian Sea.

Start the day with a guided tour through Baku's historic walled city. Enter through the Shamaxi Gate, explore the UNESCO-listed Maiden Tower and Shirvanshah's Palace. After lunch, head west into the picturesque Caucasus foothills to the mountain village of Lahij, famous for its cobbled streets, copper workshops, and traditional handicrafts.

DAY 5: VILLAGE TRADITIONS IN LAHIJ & TRANSFER TO SHEKI (BLD)

Spend the morning strolling through Lahij, browsing handmade crafts, and interacting with local artisans. Later, continue your scenic journey to Sheki, once a key Silk Road trading post. Nestled in green hills, Sheki is known for its charming streets and cultural heritage, and it will be your base for the next two nights.



Today you'll explore Sheki's top sights including the beautifully restored Khan's Palace, with its dazzling stained glass windows, and the vibrant local market. Later, take a short drive to the village of Kis to visit the historic round-towered Albanian Church. The afternoon is yours to enjoy Sheki at your own pace.

DAY 7: CROSSING INTO GEORGIA - WINE COUNTRY & MONASTERIES (BLD)

Cross the border into Georgia's Kakheti region, famous for its ancient wine-making traditions. Visit the hilltop Nekresi Monastery and the striking 16th-century Gremi Church complex. Arrive in the charming town of Telavi for an overnight stay.

DAY 8: TELAVI TO GORI - WINE TASTING & CULTURAL HERITAGE (BLD)

This morning, stroll through Telavi's local market before heading to Sighnaghi, a fortified hilltop town with beautiful views. Continue to Gori and visit the Georgian State Museum before checking into your hotel.

DAY 9: STALIN'S LEGACY, ANCIENT CAVE CITY & THE CAUCASUS MOUNTAINS (BLD)

In Gori, visit the Stalin Museum, including his birthplace and personal train carriage. Then explore the fascinating cave city of Uplistsikhe, carved into rock more than 2,000 years ago. After lunch, travel along the scenic Georgian Military Highway to Stepantsminda (Kazbegi), with a photo stop at Ananuri Fortress en route

DAY 10: GERGETI CHURCH HIKE & ANCIENT MTSKHETA (BLD)

Enjoy a morning hike (or optional jeep ride) to Gergeti Trinity Church, perched dramatically at 2,170 meters with views of Mount Kazbek. After a local family-style lunch, drive to Mtskheta, Georgia's ancient capital, to visit UNESCO-listed Jvari Monastery and Svetitskhoveli Cathedral. Arrive in Tbilisi this evening.

DAY 11: EXPLORING OLD TBILISI (BLD)

Begin the day with a guided walk through Old Tbilisi, visiting the 13th-century Metekhi Church, 4th-century Narikala Fortress, the historic Sulphur Baths, and the Anchiskhati and Sioni churches. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure to soak up the city's vibrant café culture, shop for souvenirs, or relax.

DAY 12: INTO ARMENIA – DEBED CANYON & HAGHPAT MONASTERY (BLD)

After breakfast, cross into Armenia and begin your journey through the stunning Debed Canyon. Stop at the UNESCO-listed Haghpat Monastery, one of the region's most treasured landmarks, before arriving in the forested town of Dilijan, often called the "Little Switzerland of Armenia."

DAY 13: LAKE SEVAN, SELIM CARAVANSERAI & KARAHUNJ (BLD)

Drive to the sparkling blue waters of Lake Sevan and explore the hilltop Sevanavank Monastery. Then continue south via the Selim Caravanserai, a well-preserved Silk Road resting point from 1332. End the day at Karahunj, Armenia's mysterious "Stonehenge," before arriving in the mountain town of Goris.

DAY 14: TATEV MONASTERY & DRIVE TO YEREVAN (BLD)

Ride the world's longest aerial tramway to the 9th-century Tatev Monastery, dramatically set on a cliffside. Afterward, drive north and stop at Noravank Monastery, known for its stunning canyon location and medieval carvings. Arrive in Yerevan, Armenia's lively capital city, in the evening.

DAY 15: YEREVAN CITY TOUR & FREE TIME (BLD)

This morning, explore the city's highlights including the Matenadaran Manuscript Museum, the moving Genocide Memorial, and the open-air Cascade art complex. After lunch, enjoy your final afternoon at leisure to shop, stroll Republic Square, or relax in a local café before your farewell dinner.

DAY 16: TOUR ENDS IN YEREVAN

After breakfast, your tour concludes. Hotel check-out is at noon. Transfers will be arranged for your departure flight as you bid farewell to the Caucasus with unforgettable memories of history, hospitality, and natural beauty.
