Tour Price: The price quoted in our proposal or brochure has been calculated as per the rates prevailing at the time of printing this brochure. Prices are based on land only group rates of 25 passengers or more, and on double occupancy; we are not responsible for finding you a roommate. If a roommate is not available, you must pay the single room supplement of CAD 1100 / USD 900. Prices are subject to change without notice before departure due to major currency fluctuations, changes in fuel prices and/or unforeseen economic circumstances.

Bookings and Payments: You must complete and sign the registration form and send it to us by email or mail by June 15th, 2026. Please enclose an initial non-refundable non-transferable deposit of \$1000 (remember to buy travel insurance on your deposit) per person, adult and/or child towards the cost of the tour. Deposit 2: \$1000 non refundable non-transferable due Sept 15, 2026. All cheques must be payable to 'Royal Orchid Tours and Holidays', upon which you will receive an official receipt. Receipt of your deposit shall act as your agreement to these terms and conditions. Tour prices are based on cheque / E-transfer (deon@royaleorchidtraveltours.com) / Cash payments. Credit card payments will incur an additional service fee of 2.5% of the tour price. Balance is due March 31st, 2027. Payments received after this date will incur a late fee in the amount of \$50.00.

Travel Documents: A valid passport (valid for six months after the return date of the trip) is required to travel. Royale Orchid Tours assumes no responsibility for the procurement of passports or visas. Obtaining and carrying these documents is the sole responsibility of passengers. Royale Orchid Tours will not be responsible for any delays, damages and/or losses, including missed portions of your trip due to improper travel documentation. The company will send the documents and tickets within 3 weeks before the departure date.

Air Changes, Cancellations & Refunds: Our prices are based on group bookings. They are highly restrictive and, in most instances, cannot be reissued, revalidated or exchanged. If a change is possible, a \$75 per person administrative fee, plus any applicable airline change fees, will be assessed once air tickets have been issued. Airline penalties vary depending on the carrier. Due to group bookings, this also means that there is no advanced seat selection, seating is solely under the control of the airlines. DAY 1: DAY 1: SEOUL → DAEJEON (SOLMOE SHRINE) → SEOSAN (BLD)

Solmoe Shrine – an important Catholic pilgrimage site in Korea and the birthplace of St. Andrew Kim Taegon. It offers a peaceful setting to reflect on the faith and the history of Korea's early Catholic community

Seosan Haemi International Sanctuary – a Vatican-designated international pilgrimage site in Korea, honoring the martyrs who died for their faith in the region

Haemi Eupseong Fortress – a military stronghold and administrative center, also a historically significant site where many Catholics were imprisoned and executed during the persecutions of the 19th century Dangjin, near Daejeon. One of the most important Catholic sites in Korea.

DAY 2: BORYEONG → JEONJU (BLD)

Galmaemot Martyrs Sacred Place – A site associated with the imprisonment and trial of St. Andrew Kim Taegon, the first Korean Catholic priest, before his martyrdom in 1846.

Jeondong Cathedral – A historic Catholic cathedral in Jeonju built in 1914, standing on the site where many Korean Catholics were martyred during the early persecutions.

Jeonju Hanok Village – A traditional Korean village featuring over 700 hanok houses, where visitors can experience Korean culture, architecture, and local food.

DAY 3: BOEUN → GANGNEUNG (BLD)

Meongemok Shrine – A Catholic pilgrimage site honoring the Korean martyrs who were executed here during the 1866 persecution.

Beopjusa Temple (UNESCO) – A historic Buddhist temple founded in the 6th century and part of the UNESCO World Heritage-listed Sansa, Buddhist Mountain Monasteries in Korea.

Gangneung City – A coastal city on Korea's east coast known for its beautiful beaches, coffee culture, and scenic views of the East Sea.

DAY 4: GANGNEUNG → & KOREA'S EAST COAST (BLD)

Jeongdong – Simgok Badabuchae-gil (Sea coast) – A scenic coastal walking trail in Gangneung D: Included offering dramatic cliffs, unique rock formations, and beautiful views of the East Sea.

Gangneung Local Market – A lively traditional market where visitors can experience local street food, seafood, and the vibrant atmosphere of Gangneung.

DAY 5: JECHEON → SEOUL (BLD)

Baeron Shrine – A Catholic pilgrimage site where Korea's first Catholic seminary was established in 1855. It is closely associated with Fr. Thomas Choe Yang-eop, who served and trained seminarians during the time of persecution.

Myeongdong Cathedral & Street Shopping – A historic Catholic cathedral built in 1898 and the main cathedral of the Archdiocese of Seoul, located near one of Seoul's most famous shopping districts.

JAPAN TRIP EXTENSION

Nagasaki | Tokyo | Akita

DAY 1: NAGASAKI (BLD)

Arrive in Nagasaki. Lunch at a local restaurant. Visit the Twenty-Six Martyrs Museum and Monument. Mass at the Shrine of the Martyrs. Visit Oura Cathedral.

DAY 2: NAGASAKI (BLD)

After breakfast, visit Urakami Cathedral, a prominent Catholic church located in Nagasaki, Japan. On August 9, 1945, during World War II, Nagasaki was devastated by the atomic bomb. Urakami cathedral was located near the epicenter of the bombing. The church was almost completely destroyed, but parts of it were later rebuilt. The cathedral is a moving site of both historical and spiritual significance, reflecting the resilience of the Catholic community in Japan through times of persecution and tragedy. Mass at the Cathedral. Visit the Atomic Bomb Museum and Ground Zero Peace Park. Lunch at a local restaurant. Explore the Glover Garden located on the Minami-Yamate hill, offering great views of Nagasaki's harbor and cityscape. The garden is a short distance from the Oura Church and can be accessed easily by public transport or by walking through the scenic hills of Nagasaki. Overall, Glover Garden is a unique and peaceful place to explore the legacy of Japan's interaction with the West during a pivotal time in its history, and it's also a great spot to enjoy the natural beauty and historic architecture of Nagasaki. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

DAY 3: AKITA (BLD)

Fly to Akita. Upon arrival, begin the Akita city tour. Visit the Senshu Park, site of Kubota Castle ruins. Stop for lunch at a local restaurant. After lunch, enjoy a short cultural experience with Akita's traditional crafts. Dinner at the restaurant and transfer to the hotel. Overnight in Akita.

DAY 4: AKITA (BLD)

Visit the shrine in Akita City and the wooden statue of the Virgin Mary carved from a Katsura tree. Stigmata and Tears: The statue reportedly bled from its hand and later began to weep. It wept 101 times over nearly seven years.

DAY 5: AKITA - TOKYO (BLD)

Fly to Tokyo Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner included.

DAY 6: TOKYO (BLD)

After breakfast, we will leave for the Imperial Palace, national diet building, Asakusa Sensoji kanon temple and nakamise street. Lunch at the local restaurant. Visit Tokyo Skytree and do some Ginza shopping. We will have our dinner. Transfer to our hotel and overnight in Tokyo.
